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• I.What's in a name? 何謂「衛道/護教學」?

Δ. ἀπολογία. From the Greek prefix ἀπο- ("from") and λόγος (in this context meaning logic, or reasoning)

希臘文ἀπολογία: ἀπο-出於, λόγος 邏輯、論證

- **B.** So "ἀπολογία" was a legal, courtroom term, and it meant "a <u>defense</u>"—the argument that lawyers would make for their client.
- 因此「衛道」是法律法庭術語,意思是「辯護」:是律師為自己的委託人進行辯護的論點。
- **C.** An ἀπολογία is "a well-reasoned reply; a thought-out response to adequately address all the issue(s) that might be raised."

「衛道」是「合理的回應;深思熟慮後適當地表達,以充分解決可能提出的所有問題。

III._Apologetics in Scripture 聖經中的衛道

- o 1 Peter 3:15 彼前三15
 - "Always be prepared to give an answer (ἀπολογίαν) to everyone who asks you to give the reason (λόγον) for the hope that you have."
 - 只要心裡尊主基督為聖。有人問你們心中盼望的緣由(λόγον), 就要常作 準備, 以溫柔、敬畏的心回答(ἀπολογίαν)各人。
- o Philippians 1:7 腓一7
 - "whether I am in chains or defending (τῆ ἀπολογία) and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me."
 - 無論我是在捆鎖之中,是辯明(τῆ ἀπολοχία) 證實福音的時候,你們都 與我一同得恩。
- o Philippians 1:17 腓一16
 - "The latter do so out of love, knowing that I am put here for the defense (ἀπολογίαν) of the gospel."
 - 這一等是出於愛心,知道我是為辯明(άπολογίαν)福音設立的;
- o Acts 17 徒十七

- o **Matthew 22:42** 太廿二42
 - "What do you think of the Christ? Whose son is He?"
 - 「論到基督、你們的意見如何?他是誰的子孫呢?」
- o <u>Mark 2:1-12</u> 可二1-12

IV. But how?! 如何衛道?

1 Peter 3:15-16—彼前三15-16

"In your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, *keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.

只要心裡尊主基督為聖。有人問你們心中盼望的緣由,就要常作準備,以溫柔、敬畏的心回答各人;存著無虧的良心,叫你們在何事上被毀謗,就在何事上可以叫那誣賴你們在基督裡有好品行的人自覺羞愧。

- 1. **Who** 'needs' to hear my defense of the faith? **誰**「需要」聽我為信仰辯護?
 - o Christians and non-Christians 基督徒和非基督徒
- 2. **How** do *I* "do" it? 我當**怎麼「**作」?
 - o Every situation and person (including you) is different 因人、事、物而異。
- 3. Where do I begin? 我該**從何**開始?
 - o Most important is to first listen and understand their viewpoint
 - o 最重要的是先聆聽並了解對方的觀點
- 4. **What** should be my focus? 我該聚焦於什麼?
 - o The ultimate focus: 首要的焦點
 - i. The life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. That's the heart of Christianity. That's the key to faith!
 - o 耶穌的降生,受死和復活;這是基督教的核心,信仰關鍵。
 - i. The essential difference between Christianity and absolutely every other religion:
 - o 基督教和其他宗教根本且完全不同之處。
 - i. Bring people to the place where they are thinking about the New Testament. Why? Because the New Testament—specifically, the Gospel accounts—are:

- 3. Therefore, the natural questions to ask are: "Are they true? Are they reliable documents? Do they accurately record what actually happened, and what was actually said?"
 - 所以,自然而然的問:「他們是真的嗎?是可靠的文獻嗎?所 記載的是真實無誤的記載了真人真事和言談嗎?」
- 4. Recognize that the answers to these questions are not a matter of "faith"—they are actually questions that can be scientifically, logically investigated. That's why they are topics that Apologetics can address.

- o The historical reliability of the Gospels 福音書在歷史上的可靠性。
 - i. Consider 鐵證待判;作者: 麥道衛著
- o Concerning the reliability of the New Testament:新約的可靠性
 - i. There is overwhelming evidence that the Gospel accounts are reliable documents that present well-tested and well-challenged information.
 - o 極多的證據証明福音書的記載是可靠的資料,提供了經過充分 檢驗和經得起考驗的資訊。
- o The goal of Apologetics: to get people to reconsider their ideas about what's true and what's not.

o Never be afraid of challenges—God's Word is the Truth! Even if you don't have the exact answer at the moment, you can be sure that:
